#### Think Wide Open Statement

Purchase College's motto is "Think Wide Open." It's our way of learning, teaching and being and so much more. By choosing Purchase, students make a conscious decision to join an intense community with a deep respect for individuality and diversity and an unparalleled environment of creativity and innovation. The works I've submitted for the "Think Wide Open" dissection are two animations I made. One is the more traditionally-crafted "Ana Beirut" and the other is a work modeled in the Maya program — a 3D piece called "Rete Mirabile." "Ana Beirut" is stop-motion piece crafted frame by frame in a more traditional animation style. The "Think Wide Open" theme jives with the storyline of the animation, wherein a Lebanese immigrant details her journey from the bomb-riddled roads of Beirut to the more settled streets of New York City. Her identity is still that of a Lebanese woman however she is able to free her mind from the skeleton memories overtaking Beirut's ash-ridden landscape and instead turns over a new leaf in New York. Though her mind is still disheveled by the war-torn aspects of her homeland she eventually lets loose the tethers of what once was and settles within a completely new environment, embracing the latter with her mind sprawled open.

The piece "Rete Mirabile" also represents the "Think Wide Open" aspect of individuality and diversity. The piece explores the nuances of a rete mirabile, which is a system of blood vessels and arteries commonly found in warm-blooded vertebrates. By exploring the aesthetic details of this "wonderful net" on a minute structural level, the viewer is able to look past the outer visual structure and explore a different perspective -- the intricacies within the blood vessels themselves. The microscope acts as the vessel with which the viewer is segued into a beautiful representation of a warm-blooded net most often overlooked by the human eye. Such is an illustration of individuality at it's core; giving life to identity on a microscopic level.
