

DRAW THE CIRCLES

Use the drinking glass to draw 3 circles on a piece of orange construction paper.

Cut them out.



CREATE A CONE

Hold all 3 circles together and fold in half. Then fold in half again to create a cone shape.

MAKE A CUT

Cut a slit from the curved end of the paper cone, leaving about 1/3 of it untouched.

OPEN THE CONE

Unfold the cone.
Then cut more
slits so the flower
has multiple
petals.

THE PETALS

To create a fuller flower, layer several petals on top of each other. Attach them together using a few drops of glue.

ROLL &: CUT

Roll your "paper comb" into a tight bundle. Make a few cuts into each triangular section until you're left with numerous wisps of orange paper.

DRAW &: CUT

To create the flower's stamen, draw a shape that resembles a hair comb on a strip of paper. Cut it out.

COMPLETE YOUR FLOWER

Add a few drops of glue to the center of your flower. Gently press the base of the stamen into the glue and hold for 30 seconds. Repeat the steps to create a full bouquet!








Connect the Dots

Secure the top of your book with masking tape so the crepe paper doesn't slip when you are cutting out the shapes. Carefully cut out all the shapes on the interior of the template.
