

Day 1 October 14, Sunday: Depart for Italy

Depart from New York's JFK International Airport on our overseas flight with Alitalia to Rome, Italy.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served in-flight.

Day 2 October 15, Monday: Welcome to Rome!

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our private tour bus and continue to the "Eternal City." On our orientation tour by coach history will be made visible in the Roman ruins, 15th century churches, 17th century palaces and 20th century monuments. We will stop for independent lunch and free time in Trastevere; a charming neighborhood with many shops and cafes. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica di Santa Maria. Mid afternoon we will go to our hotel to check-in with balance of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 3 October 16, Tuesday: Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica | Afternoon Tour of the Vatican Garden

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass, visit one of the great art collections in the world: the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and contemplate the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End your morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. On your own, with time permitting, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch. Enjoy a walking tour of the Vatican Gardens. a place of peace and quiet meditation for popes since 1279 when Nicholas III (Giovanni Gaetano Orsini, 1277-1280) moved his residence back to the Vatican from the Lateran Palace. Within the new walls, which he had built to protect his residence, he planted an orchard (pomerium), a lawn (pratellum) and a garden (viridarium). The event is recorded among other places on a stone placque which can be viewed in the "Sala dei Capitani" of the "Palazzo dei Conservatori" on Rome's Capitoline Hill. Created around the hill of Saint Egidio (where the "Palazzetto del Belvedere" is located today) and the courtyards of the Vatican Museums, this was to be the first garden in the Vatican. Pause to pray at the Lourdes Grotto in the Vatican Garden. Independent dinner.

Day 4 October 17, Wednesday: Papal Audience | Papal Basilicas of Rome

After an early breakfast, we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster and bless religious articles. Our pilgrimage group will be acknowledged during the English language portion. Independent lunch. Today we will visit major basilicas of Rome. We begin with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. Pray near the relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, reputed as painted by St. Luke, meaning Protectress of the Roman People. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. Next, visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there we continue to visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine. Independent dinner.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome.

Day 5 October 18, Thursday: Full Day at Leisure or Optional

Excursion to Naples and Pompeii (\$160)

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a full day at leisure in Rome. **Optional day trip to Naples and Pompeii** (at additional cost of \$160). Early morning, board our bus and drive south on the Autostrada del Sol, "Sun Route," via the regions of Lazio and Campania for Naples. Upon arrival we enjoy a panoramic ride of the Naples: Pass by Mergellina, Castel dell'Ovo, Plebiscito Square, The Royal Palace, and the Maschio Angioino with its triumphal arch and deep moats. Enjoy and photograph the famous view of the city, the bay and Mt. Vesuvius.

Independent lunch in Naples. After lunch, we will visit Pompeii. Explore the incredibly well-preserved remains of this ancient Roman town, where all life was suddenly stopped by an eruption of Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. The volcano collapsed higher roof-lines and buried Pompeii under 60 feet of ash and pumice, and it was lost for nearly 1700 years before its accidental rediscovery in 1748. Since then, its excavation has provided an extraordinarily detailed insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire. Today, it is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Italy. Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Basilica of the Rosary. After Mass, return to Rome. Independent dinner en route. Overnight at hotel in Rome.

Day 6 October 19, Friday: St. Paul and St. Agnes Outside-the-Walls | Catacombs | Walking Tour of Rome

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will have a unique tour of Rome and her outskirts. Drive past Tiberina Island, the Aventine Hill, the pyramid of Caius Cestius, and St. Paul's Gate, part of the ancient Aurelian Wall. Stop to visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope throughout history. Next we will visit the church of St. Agnes Outside the Walls. The body of St. Agnes lies in the catacomb beneath St. Agnes Outside the Walls. This is the church where the traditional blessing of two lambs takes place on her feastday. The lambs are brought to the Carmelite monastery in Rome, and at Easter time their wool is shorn and used to make the pallium, a stole-like vestment worn by Archbishops. Continue to the Catacombs of St. Callixtus. Discovered in the mid second century, they took their name from the deacon St. Callistus. Dozens of martyrs and 16 popes were buried in the catacombs. Celebrate Mass at the Catacombs. Independent lunch. This afternoon, we will have a walking tour of Rome. As we visit churches and walk through squares with ornate grand fountains, you will understand why Rome is known as the birthplace of the Baroque style. We begin at the Spanish Steps and Piazza di Spagna, one of the most exclusive and fashionable shopping areas in the world. Continue to the Trevi Fountain nestled in the historic center of Rome, then on to the Pantheon, the best-preserved building from ancient Rome, completed in the reign of Hadrian. Its magnificent dome is a lasting testimony to the genius of Roman architects and as the building stands virtually intact it offers a unique opportunity for the modern visitor to step back. Next we will visit the lively Piazza Navona, with time to visit the Church of St Agnes in Agony, browse through the artists' stalls, and try one of Rome's most famous products, a "tartufo" (ice cream) at the Gelateria "Tre Scalini." A visit to the nearby Church of San Luigi dei Frrancesi to see The Calling of St. Matthew, painted by Baroque master Caravaggio. Tonight, enjoy a Farewell to Rome dinner at a local restaurant. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship, and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music. Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 7 October 20, Saturday: Rome | Assisi | St. Mary of the Angels

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we leave Rome for Assisi. After a two and half-hour ride, we will arrive at the town dedicated to St. Francis, the young friar who turned to God and established an order that has grown stronger over the centuries. Upon arrival, celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great Basilica built in 1569 and crowned by the magnificent dome designed by Alessi. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered, the place where Clare received the habit from Francis, and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. You will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement, view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Independent lunch. Check-in at hotel in Assisi. Balance of the day at leisure in Assisi.

Day 8 October 21, Sunday: Basilica of St. Francis | Eremmo delle Carceri | San Daminao

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Early morning, walk to the Basilica of St. Francis to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis. After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower Basilica dates from 1228 to 1230, and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows, and paintings done by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper Basilica, built from 1230 - 1253, you will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Independent lunch. Our guide will take us, by taxis, to the Eremo delle Carceri (Hermitage), a few miles outside the town of Assisi, situated on the forest clad slopes of Mt. Subasio. This is where St. Francis often retired to pray. Here, in the midst of the lush green forest and the singing birds, one gets a deep sense of the spirit of St. Francis. Time will be given for prayer and reflection. On the way back to Assisi we stop to visit visit San Damiano the place where St. Clare lived and died. According to tradition, in this place St. Francis composed the Canticle of Creation.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Assisi.

Day 9 October 22, Monday: Return from Rome

Early morning, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on Alitalia from New York JFK International Airport. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$3,095.00 per person sharing a twin room.) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DÉVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available but we discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$895.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily, plus five (5) dinners, including a Farewell to Rome Dinner with wine and entertainment.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
