Romans says: Written to the Romans from Corinthus, and sent by Phebe servant of the church at Cenchrea,

<u>I Corinthians</u> says: The first epistle to the Corinthians was written from Philippi by Stephanas, and Fortunatus, and Achaicus and Timotheus.

2 Corinthians says: The second epistle to the Corintians was written from Philippi, a city of Macedonia, by Titus and Lucas.

Galatians says: Unto the Galatians written from Rome

Ephesians says: Written from Rome unto the Ephesians by Tychicus

Philippians says: It was written to the Phillippians from Rome by Epaphroditus.

Colossians says: Written from Rome to the Colossians by Tychicus and Onesimus.

- 1 Thessalonians says: The first epistle unto the Thessalonians was written from Athens.
- 2 Thessalonians says: The second epistle to the Thessalonians was written from Athens.
- 1 Timothy says: The first to Timothy was written from Laodicea which is the chiefest city of Phrygia Pacatiana.
- <u>2 Timothy</u> says: the second epistle unto Timotheus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians, was written from Rome, when Paul was brought before Nero the second time.

<u>Titus</u> says: It was written to Titus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Cretians, from Nicopolis of Macedonia.

Philemon says; Written from Rome to Philemon, by Onesimus a servant. (I do remember this one as accurate)

<u>Hebrews</u> says: Written to the Hebrews from Italy by Timothy. Some KJV bibles now say Paul wrote the book of Hebrews. But, in all my studies as well as the AKJV bible which states that this letter's author is "unknown".
