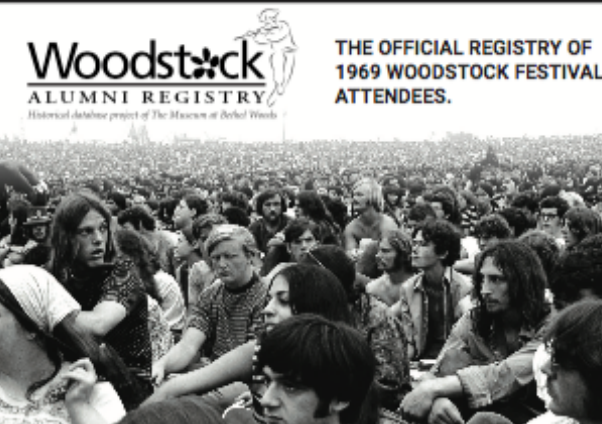
VISIT THE WOODSTOCK MONUMENT for the perfect photo op, and tag us at #BethelWoods #BWBucketList

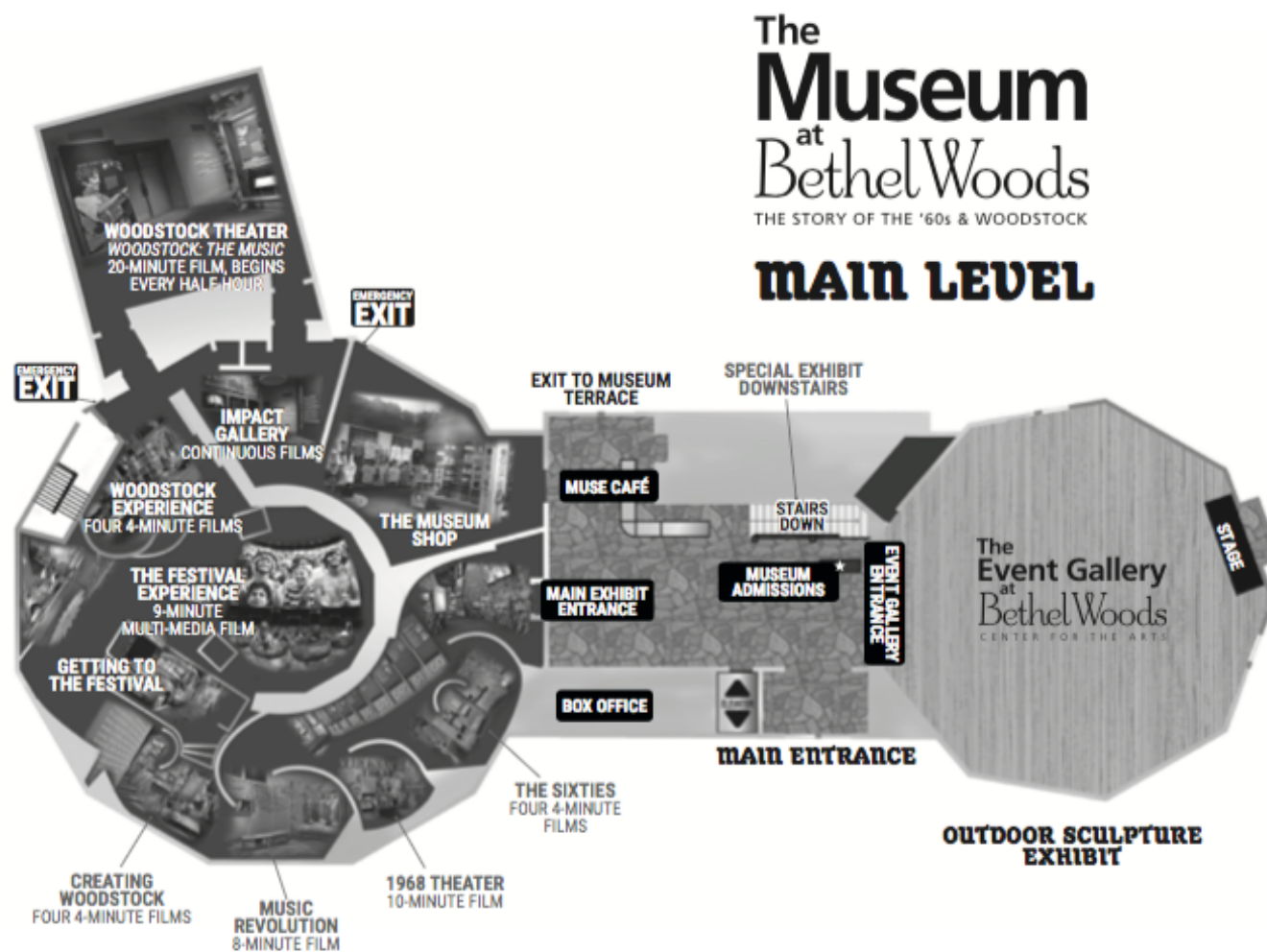

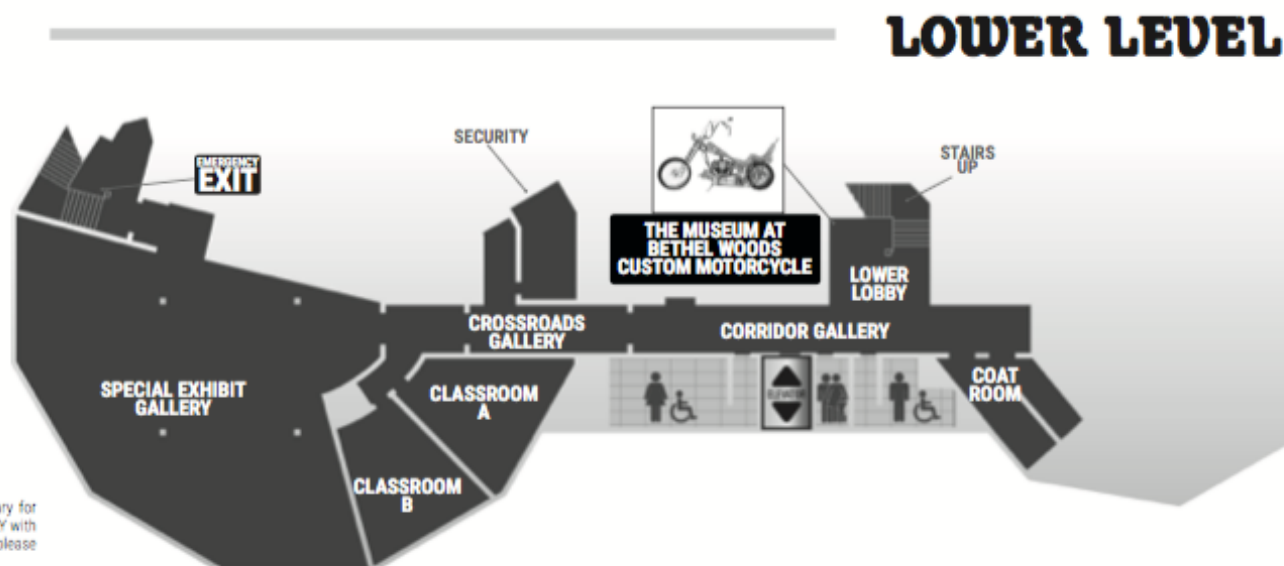
