

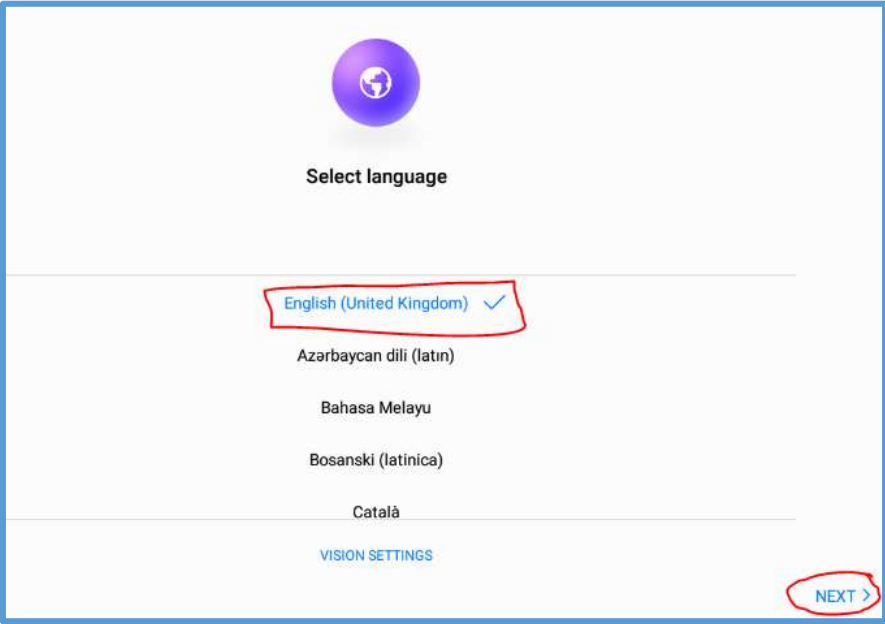

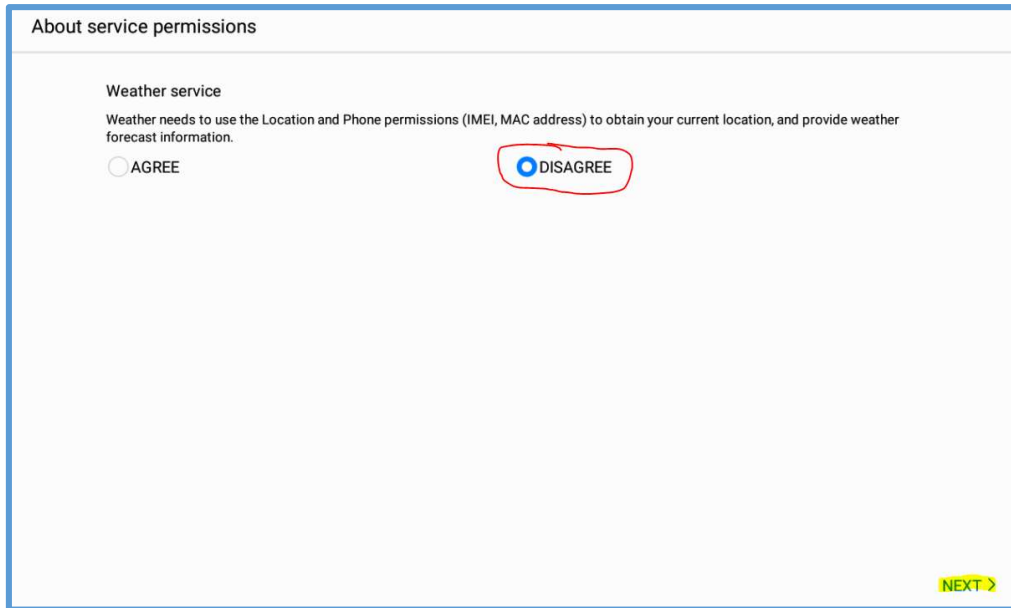

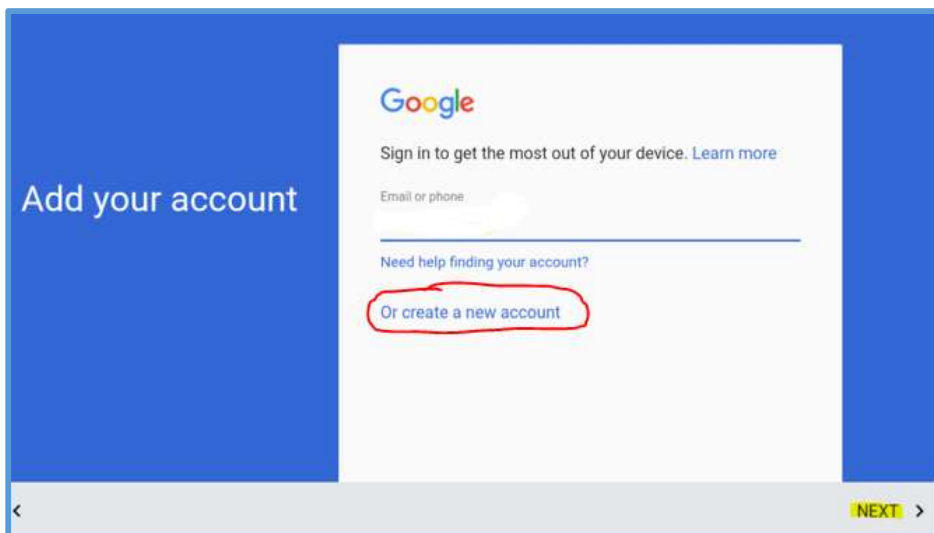


5. Connect to your **NEW WIRELESS NETWORK** installed for the purpose of Part-Ex Appraisal Tool

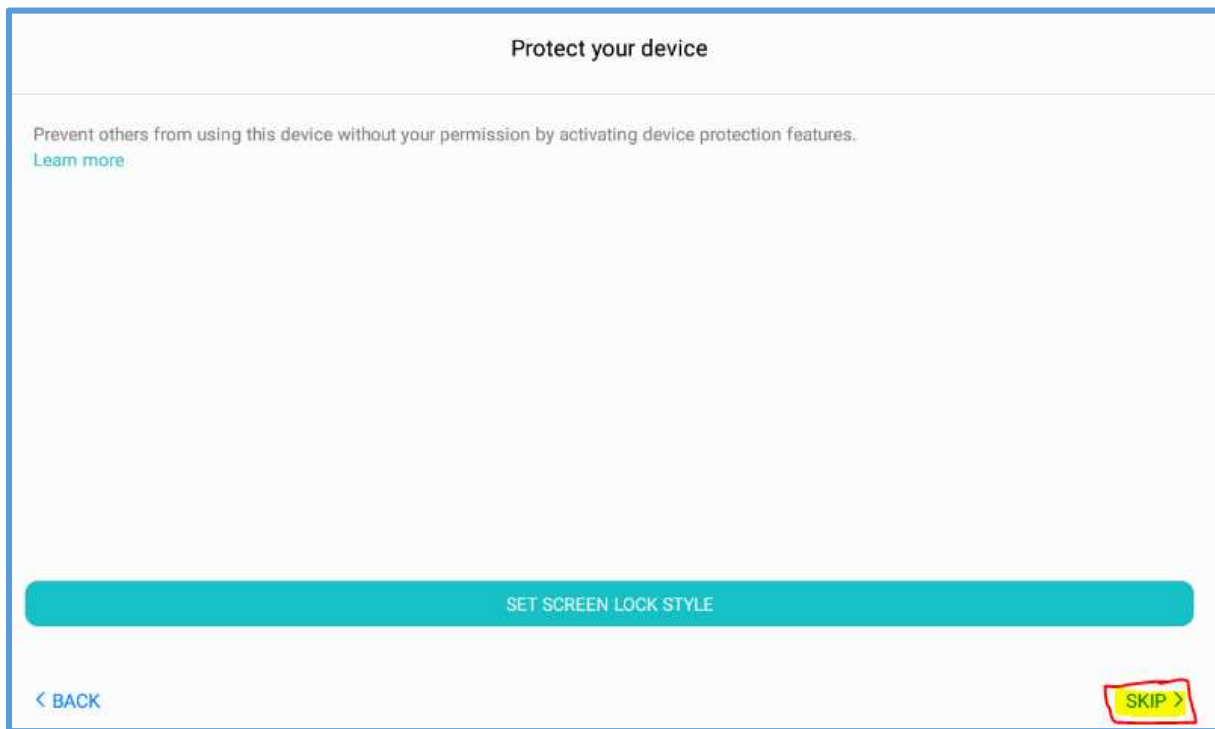

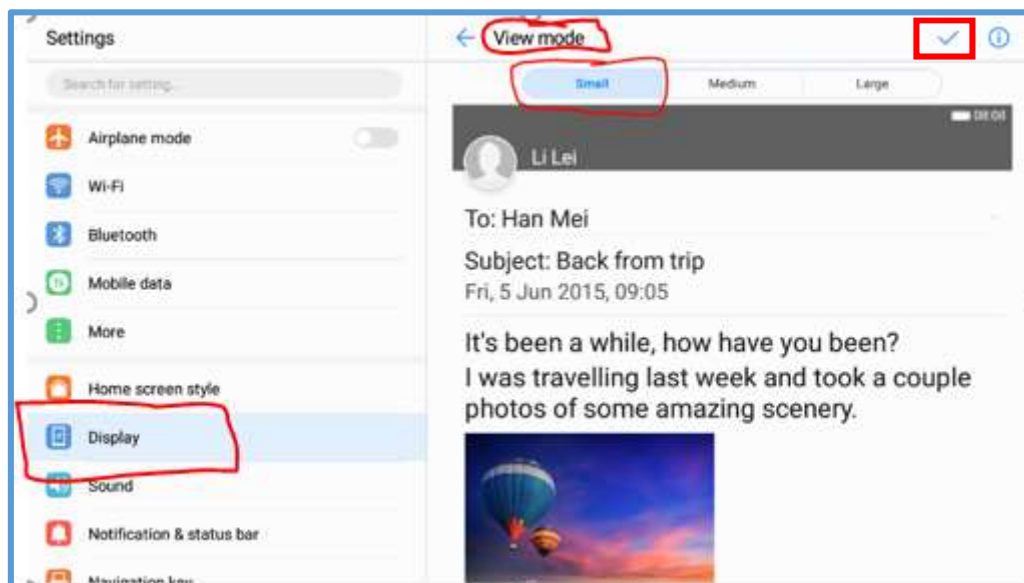

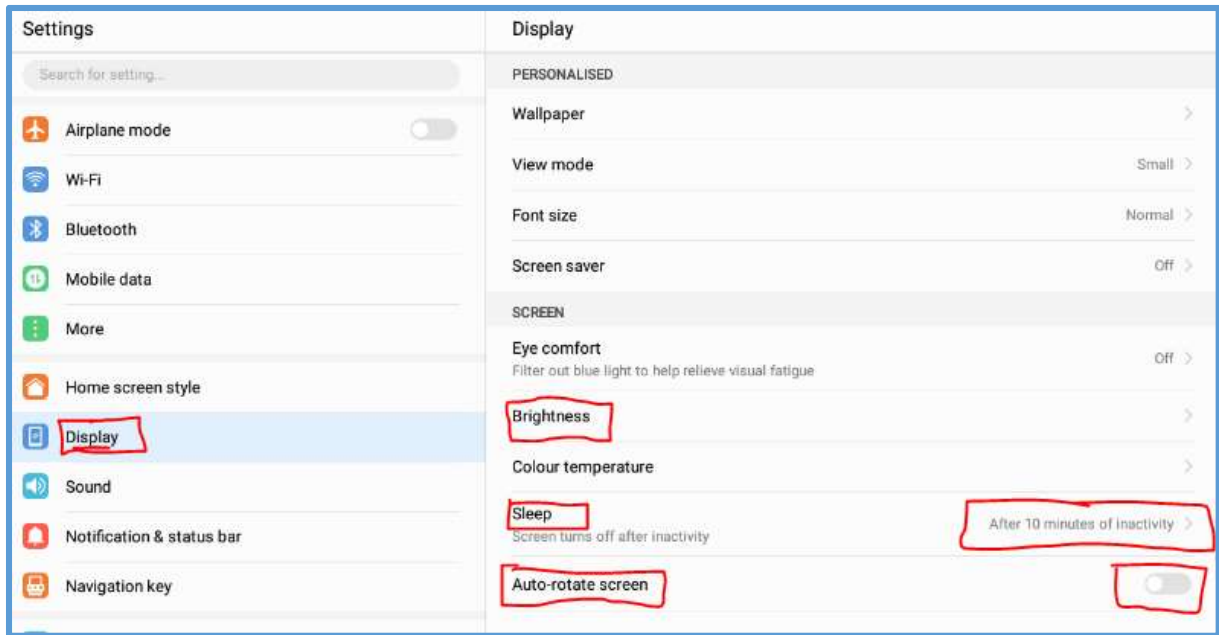
i. 'View Mode' > set to **Small** and click the tick (Tablet will restart upon selection)

iii. 'Sleep' > set to **10 minutes** (this is the maximum)

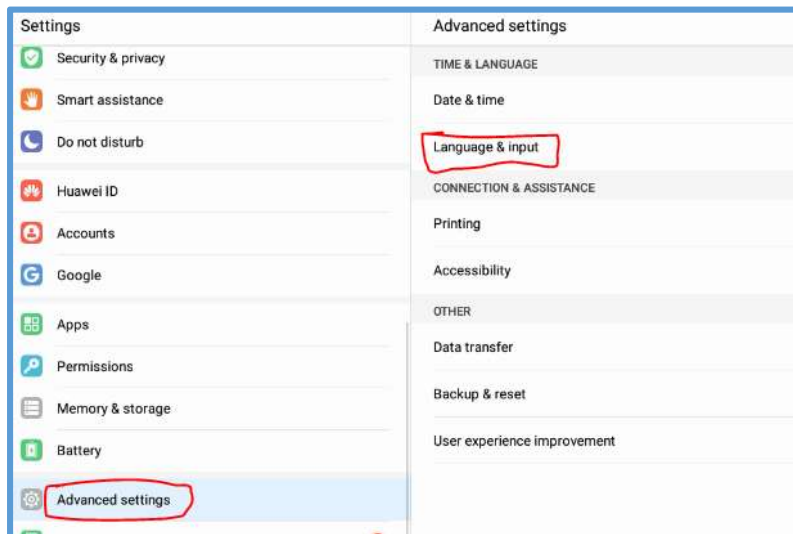
iv. 'Auto-Rotate' > Turn **Off**



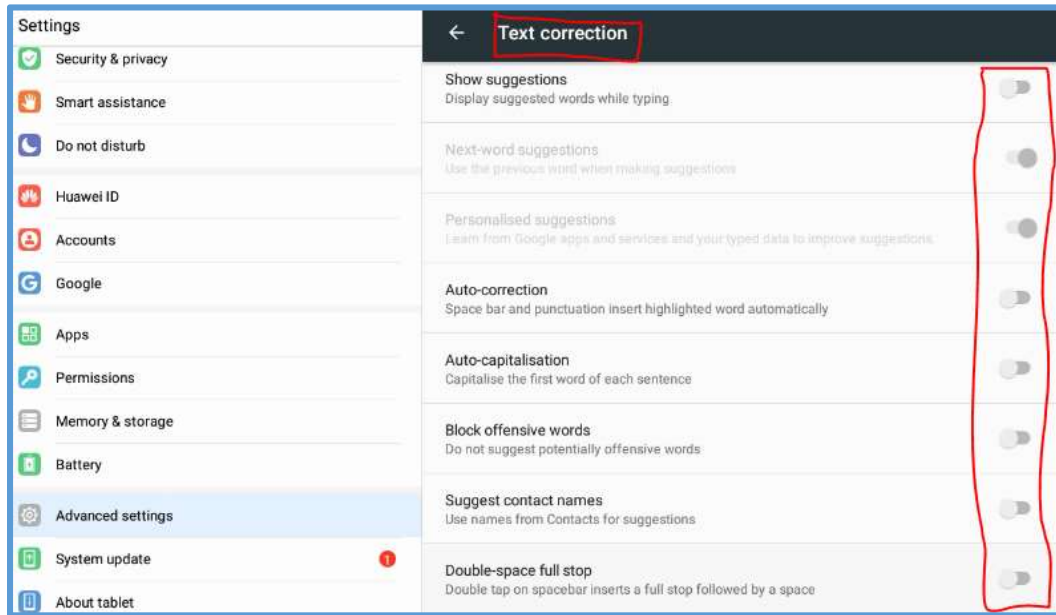

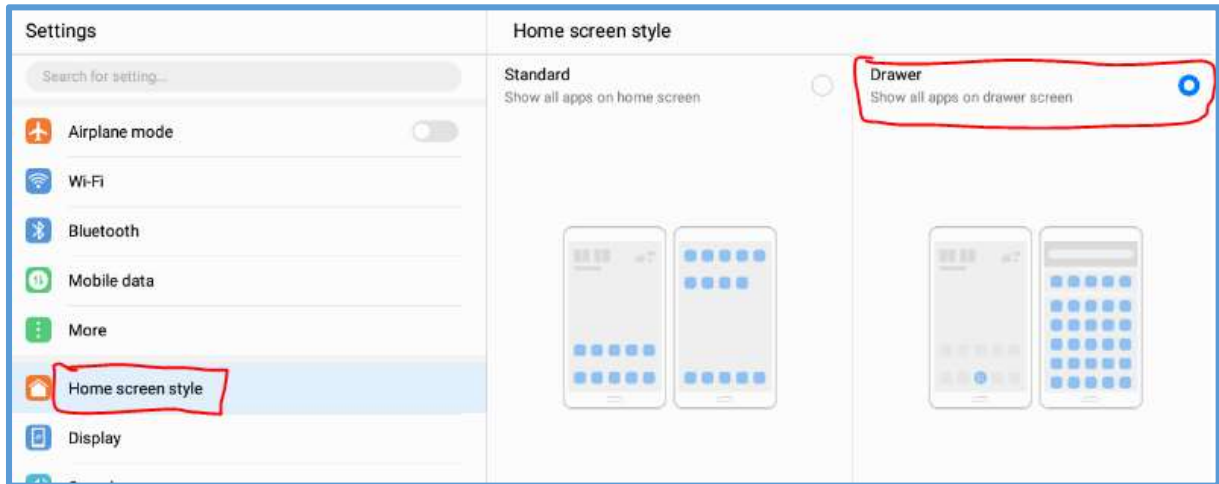

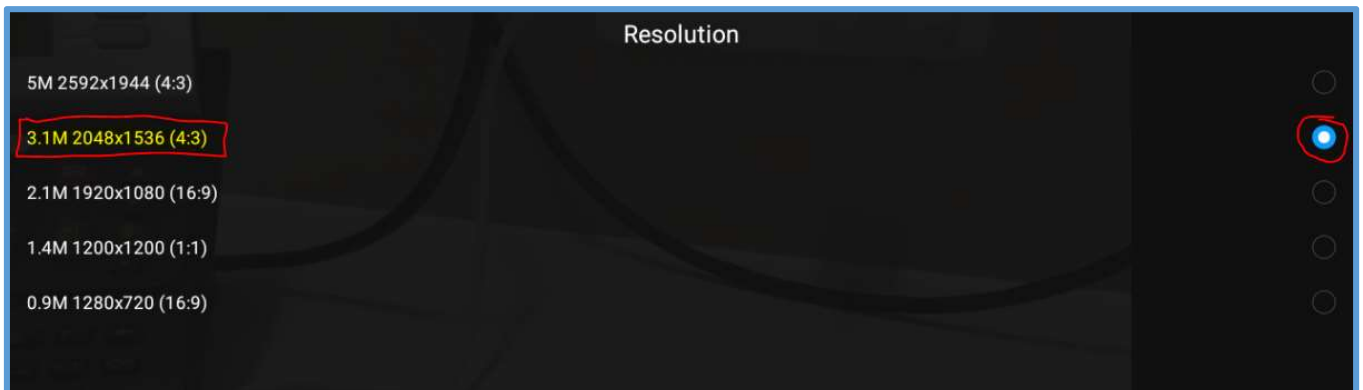
11. Update Google Chrome Browser (if required, please note an update may not be outstanding)

 - i. Set 'Resolution' to > '(4:3) 3M'

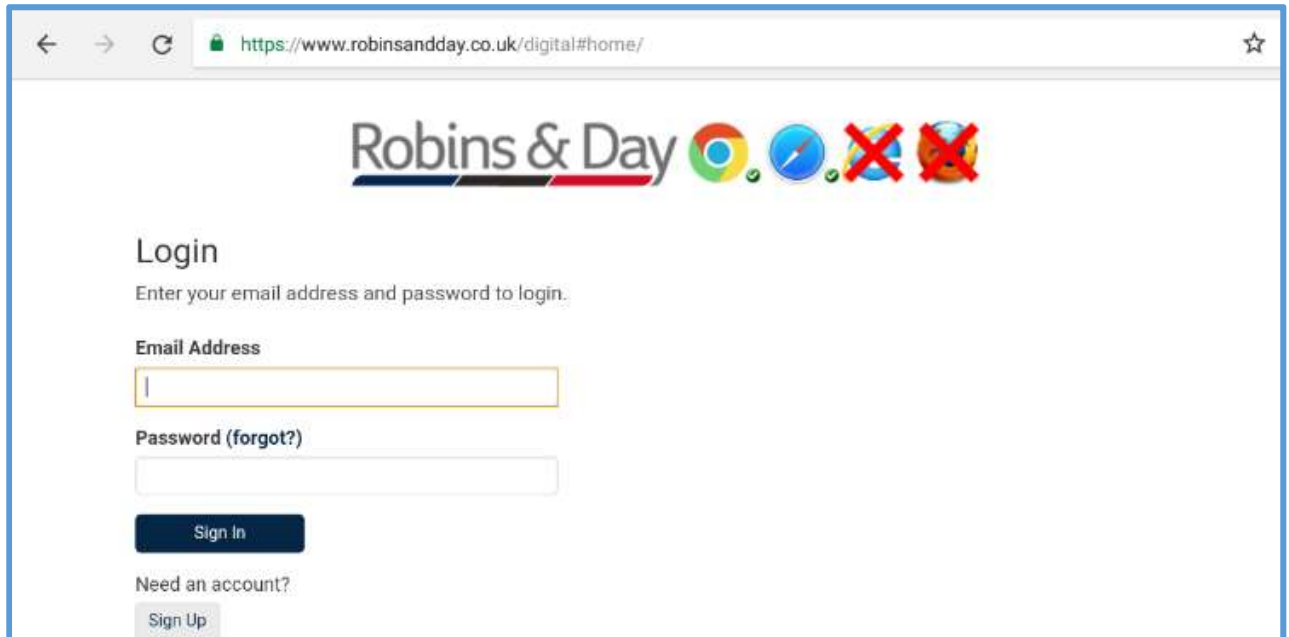


13. Clear your Tablet Home Screen of All Apps - <https://youtu.be/RsGjlfexPZI>

a. You should now see the login page to the appraisal app

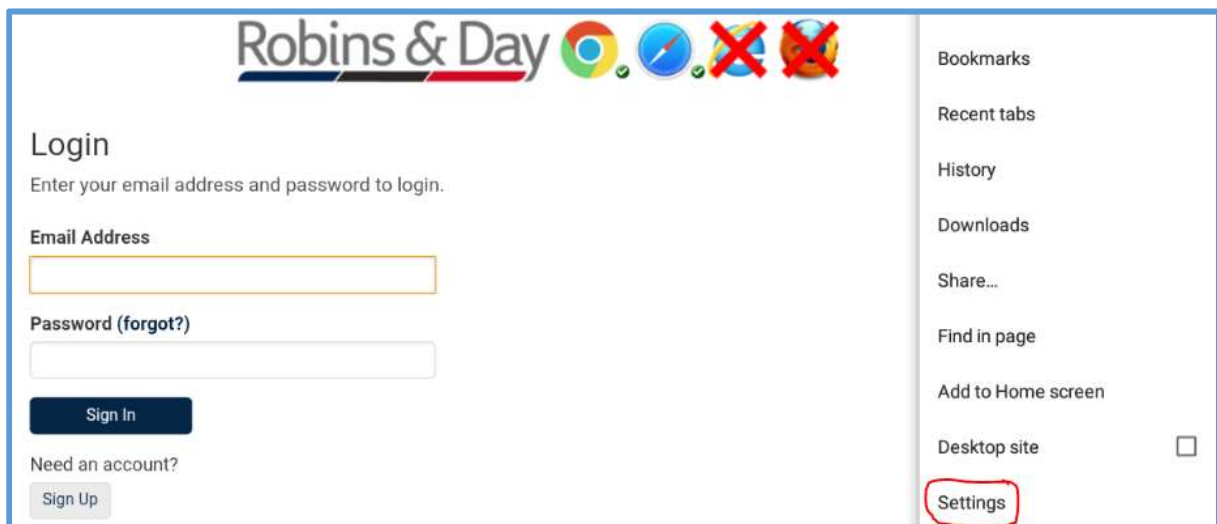

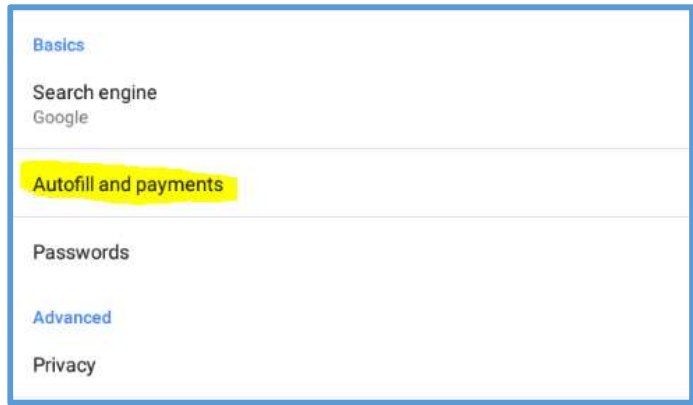
i. Click on the 3 dots icon next to the favourite icon in the 'Chrome' browser



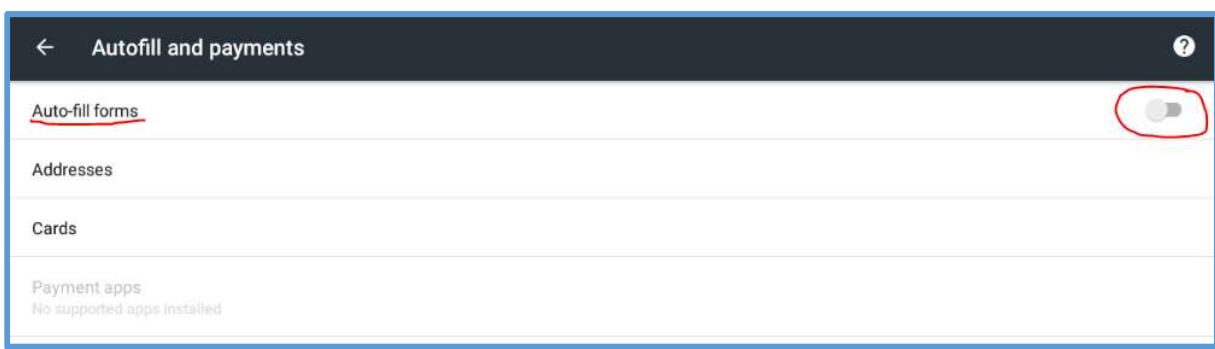
ii. Click on Settings



iii. Click 'Autofill and Payments'



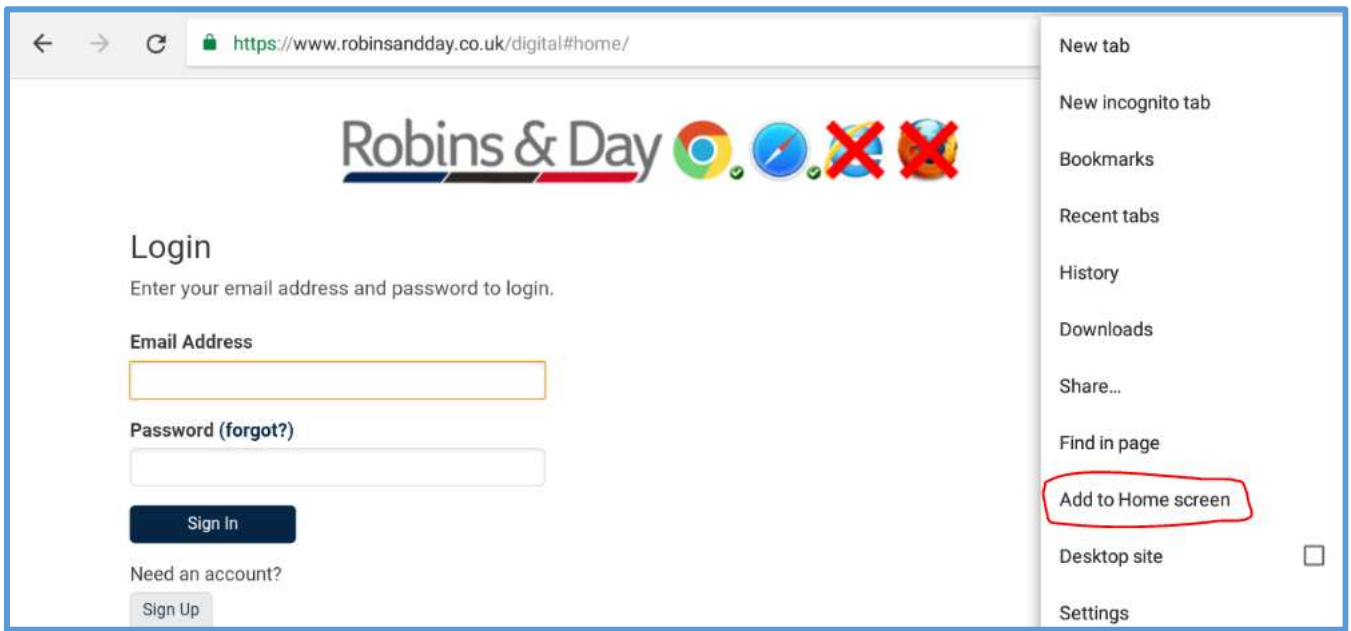
iv. Turn off 'Auto-fill forms'
