I want to give meaning to my life by sharing with you what I have realized:

1- You won’t ever get anything by wasting your time and energy on work that you don’t enjoy because if you want to be successful then you should enjoy what you are doing. Your patience, passion and dedication will only arise for things you love doing the most.

2- Other’s opinions shouldn’t even matter. These opinions will only be there to scare you or be an unnecessary hindrance in your way. Your job is to listen to yourself and those gut feelings inside you. People will call you crazy but if you are right then they will call you a legend too.

3- You are responsible for your life so take full control of things that continue to happen around you every day. It is time to say goodbye to bad habits and adopt a healthier lifestyle. Don’t just procrastinate. Make things happen.

4- Appreciate people who love you the most. Your friends and family will be your only source of support and love forever. Never take them for granted.

"We care so much about the health and integrity of our body

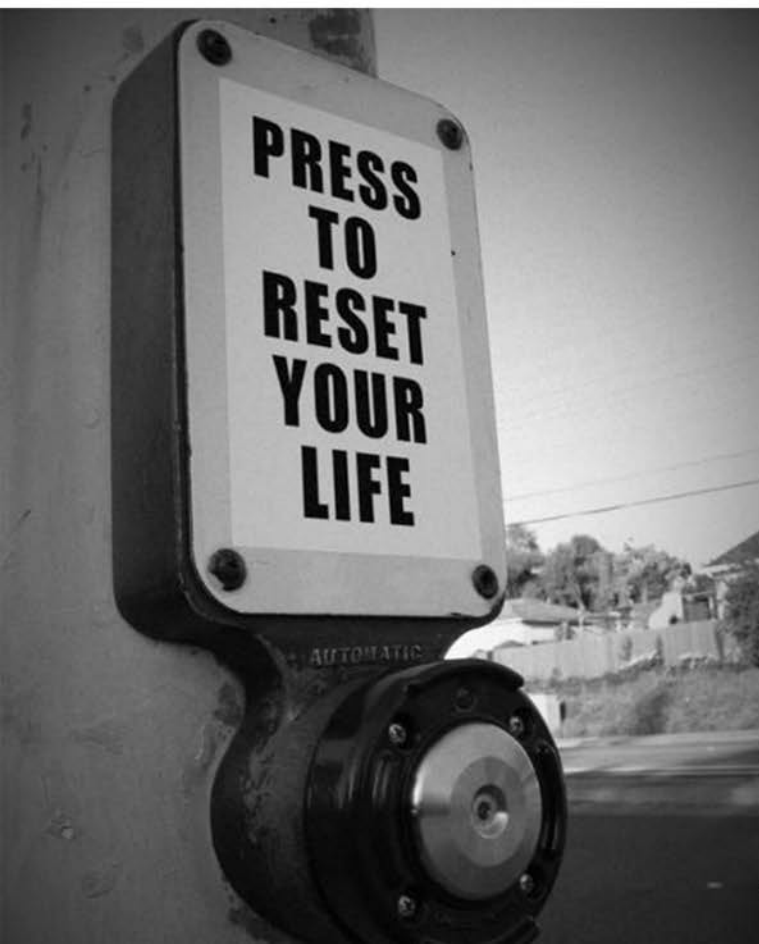
that until death, we don't notice that the body is nothing more than a box – a parcel for delivering our personality, thoughts, beliefs and intentions to this world.

He is known for his film roles as shooting victim Oscar Grant in the drama **Fruitvale Station** (2013), boxer Adonis Creed in the *Rocky* sequel film **Creed** (2015) and main antagonist Erik Killmonger in **Black Panther** (2018), all three of which were directed by Ryan Coogler.

Award winning Hollywood Reporter film critic Todd McCarthy wrote that Jordan reminded him of "**a young Denzel Washington**".

Jordan has lived in Los Angeles since 2006. He grew up in a religious household and now considers himself to be spiritual. As of 2018, he lives with his parents in a Sherman Oaks home that he purchased.

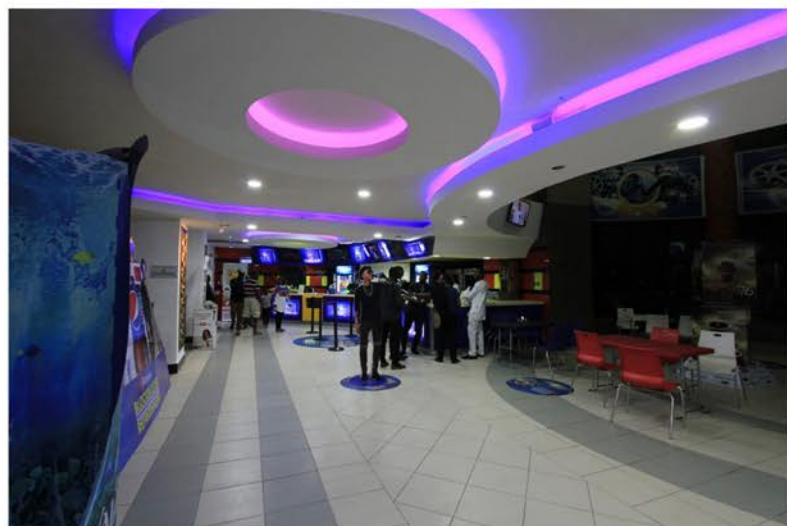
Jabi Lake Park

The very moment Nick came to terms with this reality, and started manning up to his circumstances, step by step,

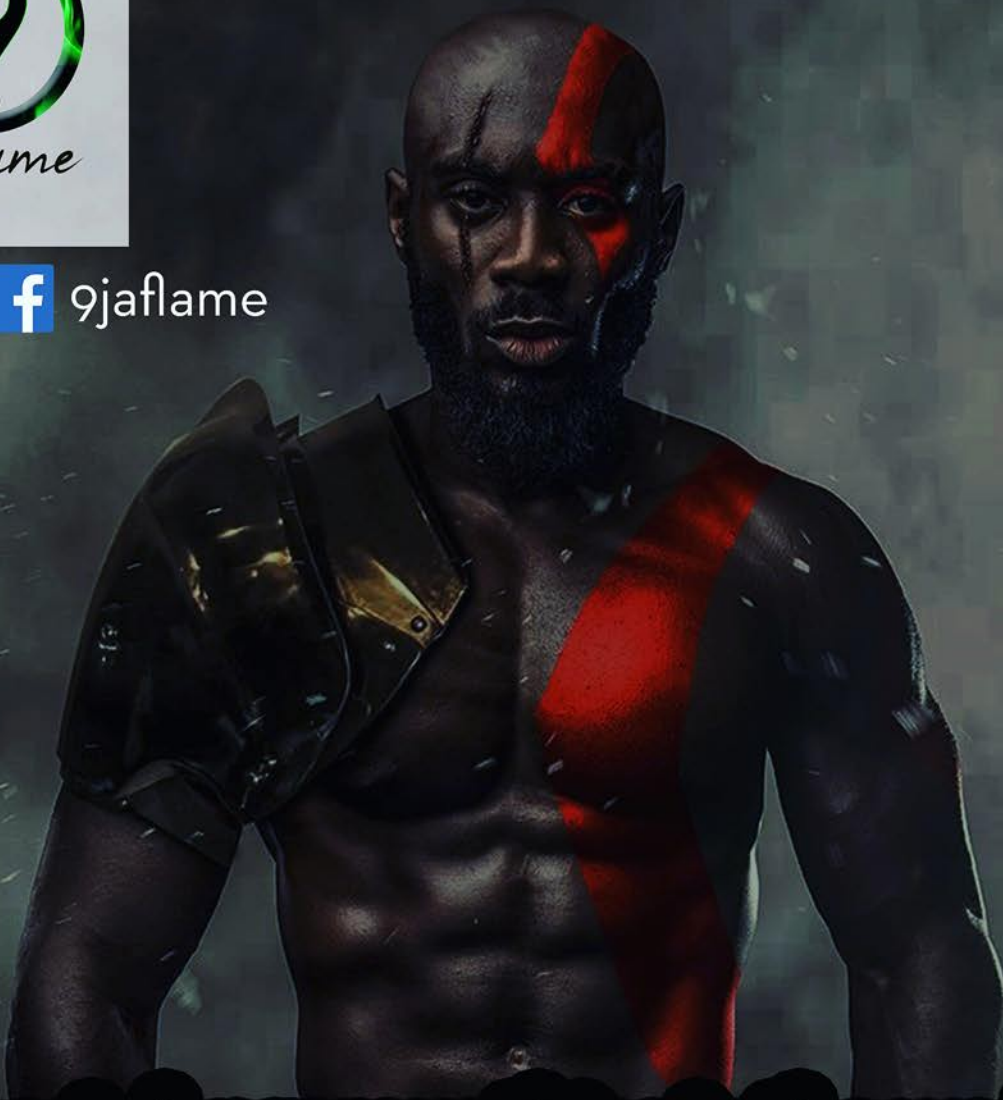

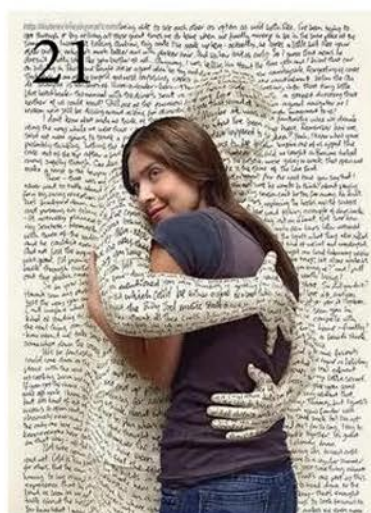
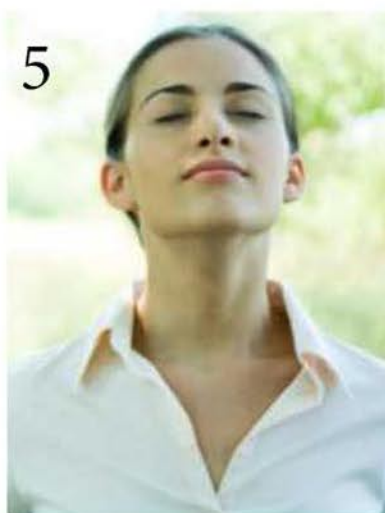
10. Doing something for hours, then returning to your phone and finding it full of text messages and missed calls.

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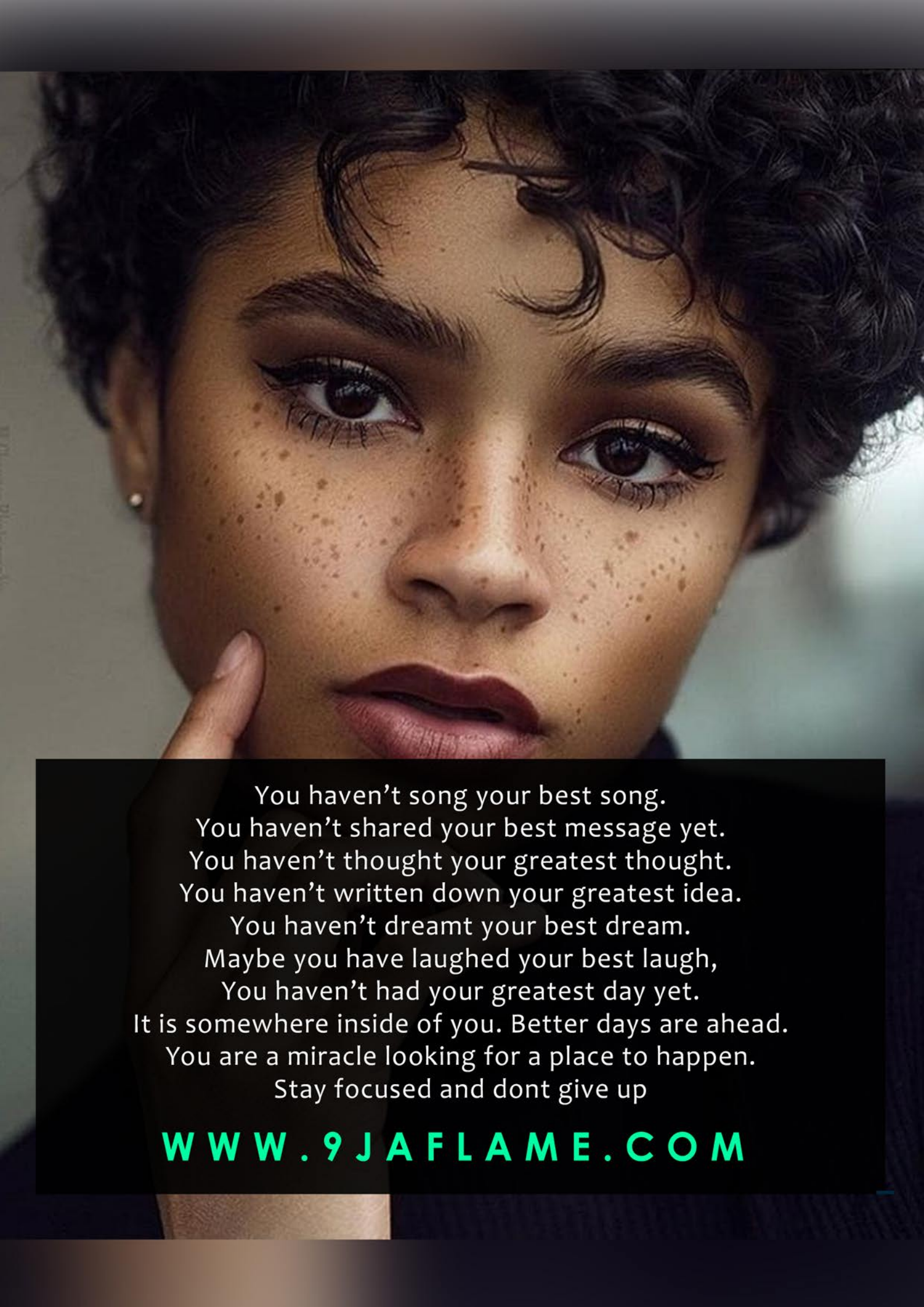


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
