Thank you for contacting the Texas Secretary of State. As a note, an S-Corp is a federal tax designation rather than an entity type. After researching further, it appears that your entity is a for-profit corporation.

That being said, in order to convert an entity from a for-profit corporation to a non-profit corporation, you must draft your own documents to be filed with us. You may refer to form 647 (Word, PDF) for some more details, keeping in mind that 647 is intended to assist in drafting documents to convert from a foreign jurisdiction to Texas.
