

Instruction Text:

Please use a black or blue pen to mark your ballot. To vote for your choice in each contest, completely fill in the box provided to the left of your choice.

To vote for a write-in candidate, completely fill in the box provided to the left of the words "Write-In" and write in the name of the candidate on the line provided. A write-in vote will not be counted unless the vote is for a declared write-in candidate.

To vote a straight Republican, Democratic, or Libertarian ticket for all Republican, Democratic, or Libertarian candidates, except for candidates for COUNTY and TOWN COUNCIL MEMBER AT-LARGE, make a voting mark on or in the box of the corresponding party, and do not make any other marks on this ballot.

To vote for any candidate for COUNTY and TOWN COUNCIL MEMBER AT-LARGE you must make another voting mark for each candidate you wish to vote for. Your straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office. If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question you must make another voting mark in the appropriate box on the ballot.

You are not required to vote a straight party ticket. If you do not wish to vote a straight party ticket, do not make a mark in this section, and proceed to voting the ballot by office.
