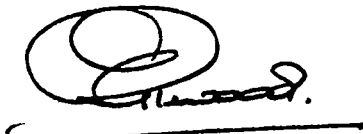

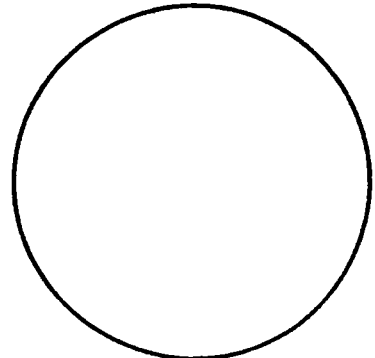

I ELAINE DILNOTT COOPER of 52 Church Mead Hassocks West Sussex HEREBY REVOKE all former testamentary dispositions made by me and DECLARE this to be my last will

1. I APPOINT the partners at the date of my death in the firm of **DONNE MILEHAM & HADDOCK** of Frederick Place Brighton East Sussex or the firm which at that date has succeeded to and carries on its practice (and I express the wish that two and only two of such partners shall prove my will and act initially in its trusts) and I further express the wish that if **SIMON DAVID LENEY** shall be such a partner at the date of my death he shall be one of such proving partners to be the executors and trustees of this my will and they or the survivors of them or other the trustees for the time being hereof are hereinafter called "my trustees"

2. I WISH to be cremated in so far as my body is not used for the purposes of medical research

3. I GIVE the following pecuniary legacy (free of tax) namely to **THE WESTFIELD TRUST** (charity reg no 800459) c/o The Old House Kidderpore Avenue London NW3 7ST the sum of fifty thousand pounds absolutely

4. (1) I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH to my trustees all my estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever whether real or personal movable or immovable including any property over which I have a general power of appointment by will (except any property otherwise effectually disposed of hereby or by any codicil hereto) UPON TRUST at their discretion to sell the same or to retain the same or any part thereof in its actual state of investment or condition at my death and to pay out of the net monies to arise from such sale and any ready monies comprised in my estate my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts (including all taxes and duties hereinafter directed to be borne by the trust fund) and the legacies given hereby or by any codicil hereto

(2) I DECLARE that subject as herein elsewhere provided all inheritance tax and other taxes and duties (if any) payable on or by reason of my death in respect of my estate shall be borne by the trust fund and the expression "free of tax" in this my will or in any codicil hereto shall mean free of all such taxes and duties as aforesaid

5. MY TRUSTEES shall stand possessed of the residue of such monies and of the investments from time to time representing the same and of any property comprised in my estate for the time being remaining unconverted (hereinafter called "the trust fund") UPON TRUST to divide the same into eight equal parts and to hold the same:

(1) as to one such part for AGE CONCERN of 60 Pitcairn Road Mitcham Surrey

(2) as to one such part for HELP THE AGED of 8 Denman Street London W1

(3) as to one such part for SHELTER-NATIONAL CAMPAIGN FOR THE HOMELESS of 157 Waterloo Road London SE1

(4) as to one such part for ROYAL UNITED KINGDOM BENIFICENT ASSOCIATION of 6 Avonmore Road London W1

(5) as to one such part for OXFAM of 274 Banbury Road Oxford

(6) as to one such part for THE NATIONAL TRUST of 36 Queen Anne's Gate London SW1

(7) as to one such part for ALONE IN LONDON ASSOCIATION of West Lodge 190 Euston Road London NW1

(8) as to one such part for THE WESTFIELD TRUST

AND I DECLARE that the receipt of the treasurer or other proper officer

of each of the aforementioned organisations or institutions shall be a good and sufficient discharge to my trustees AND I FURTHER DECLARE that if the trusts hereinbefore declared of and concerning any share of the trust fund shall fail or determine then from the date of such failure or determination such share shall accrue and be added to the other shares in the trust fund in equal proportions and be held upon the like trusts and subject to the like powers and provisions as those affecting such other shares therein

6. IN the administration of my estate and the execution of the trusts hereof my trustees shall have in addition to the powers conferred on them by the general law the following powers:

- (1) Power to treat as income all income from any part of my estate regardless of the period in which the same shall have accrued and to disregard all rules of apportionment whether legal or equitable
- (2) Power to insure against loss or damage by fire and from any other peril any property for the time being comprised in my estate or any trust fund created by this my will to any amount and notwithstanding that any person is absolutely entitled to such property and to pay the premiums for such insurance out of the income or capital of the trust fund or out of the income or capital of such property or any trust fund comprising such property and any money received by my trustees under any such policy shall be treated as though it were the proceeds of sale of such property
- (3) Power to permit any trustee who is a professional or business person to charge and be paid all usual professional and other fees for work done by him or his firm including work which a trustee not being a professional or business person could have done personally such charges and fees being a first charge on my estate and treated as a
