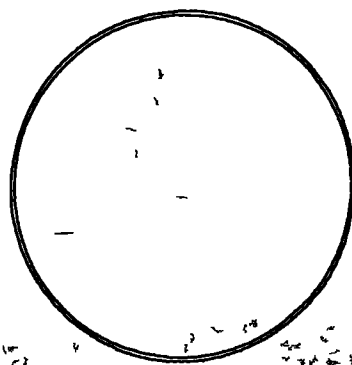
and it is hereby certified that an Inland Revenue affidavit has been delivered wherein it is shown that the gross value of the said estate in Great Britain

1 I HEREBY REVOKE all former Wills and testamentary dispositions
heretofore made by me AND DECLARE this to be my last will

2 I DESIRE that my body be cremated

3 I APPOINT my Sister KATHLEEN CLAIRE SWAN of Rothbury 40
Folders Lane Burgess Hill aforesaid and the senior Partner for
the time being of Messrs. Gates & Co. Solicitors of Burgess Hill
and Brighton (hereinafter collectively called "my Trustees") to
be the EXECUTORS and TRUSTEES of this my Will

4 I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my said Sister Kathleen Claire
Swan absolutely and free of all duties payable on my death all
personal chattels as defined by Section 55 (i) (x) of the
Administration of Estates Act 1925 belonging to me and not
otherwise specifically bequeathed and my share in the freehold
property known as Rothbury 40 Folders Lane Burgess Hill aforesaid
which I own jointly with my said sister or in any other residence
whether freehold or leasehold and which I may own jointly with my
said Sister

5 I GIVE all my property not otherwise disposed of by this my
Will unto my Trustees UPON TRUST to sell the same (with power to
postpone sale) and out of the moneys to arise from such sale to
pay my funeral and testamentary expenses death duties and debts
and to HOLD the residue of the said proceeds of sale (hereinafter
referred to as "the said residue") UPON the trusts following
namely :-

(i) My Trustees shall hold one half share of the said residue
UPON TRUST to pay the following legacies :-

(a) To Mrs. Eileen G. Robinson Miss Fiona Robinson and Brian
L. Gover the sum of Five hundred Pounds each

(b) To Mrs. Lisa Sparks and Mrs. Joyce Strahan the sum of Two
hundred and fifty Pounds each and

(c) If the said Brian L. Gover shall predecease me to his Wife
Mrs. Constance Gover the sum of Five hundred Pounds

AND TO HOLD the remainder of the said half share UPON TRUST
for my said sister Kathleen Claire Swan for her own use and

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benefit absolutely Provided that if she shall predecease me my Trustees shall hold the remainder of the said half share in the said residue UPON TRUST to pay (a) to Brian L. Gover the sum of Two thousand Pounds (b) to Dr. John Strahan the sum of One thousand Pounds and (c) if the said Brian L. Gover shall predecease me to his wife Mrs. Constance Gover the sum of Two thousand Pounds and TO HOLD the remainder of the said half share UPON TRUST for such of them the said Mrs. Eileen G. Robinson and her four children and Mrs. Joyce Strahan and her two children as shall be living at the date of my death and if more than one in equal shares absolutely PROVIDED that if any of them shall predecease me leaving issue surviving me such issue if and when they attain the age of Twenty one years or being female shall attain that age or marry under that age shall take by substitution and if more than one in equal shares per stirpes the share of my residuary Estate which such deceased beneficiary would have taken had he or she survived me (ii) My Trustees shall hold the remaining half share of the said residue UPON TRUST to pay

(a) to Miss Sybil Corkey the sum of One thousand Pounds

(b) to Miss Doris Bradshaw and Miss Brenda K. Dillnott Cooper the sum of Five hundred Pounds each

(c) to Miss Marjorie Nye Miss Mary Nye and James K. Doonan the sum of Two hundred and fifty Pounds each

(d) to Miss Elizabeth MacHardy the sum of One hundred and fifty Pounds and

(e) to Miss May Critchley the sum of One hundred Pounds AND TO HOLD the remainder of the said remaining half share of the said residue UPON TRUST for Miss Elaine Dillnott Cooper for her own use and benefit absolutely PROVIDED that if she shall predecease me then my Trustees shall hold the remainder of the said remaining half share of the said residue UPON TRUST to pay

(a) to the Ludlow Society Shropshire the sum of One hundred Pounds

(b) to Oxfam Imperial Cancer Research Fund and the Charterhouse Rheumatism Clinic the sum of Three hundred Pounds each and TO HOLD the remainder of the said remaining half share in the said residue UPON TRUST for such of them Miss Brenda K.D. Cooper and Miss Sybil Corkey as shall be living at my death and if more than one in equal shares absolutely

6 TRUST MONEYS may at the discretion of my Trustees be invested in the purchase of or at interest upon the security of

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such stocks funds shares securities or other investments of whatever nature and wherever situate and whether involving liability or not or upon such personal credit with or without security as my Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit to the intent that my Trustees shall have the same full and unrestricted powers of investing and transposing investments in all respect as if they were absolutely entitled thereto beneficially

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I DECLARE that the receipt of the person purporting to be the Treasurer or other proper Officer for the time being of a charitable benevolent or philanthropic institution society or body of persons corporate or incorporate to which a bequest or devise is given hereby or by any Codicil hereto shall be a complete discharge of my Trustees.

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MY Executor or Trustee for the time being of this my will being a Solicitor or other person engaged in any profession or business shall be entitled to charge and be paid all usual professional and other charges for business done and all time spent by him or his firm in connection with the proving of this my will or the execution or exercise of the trusts and powers hereof whether in the ordinary course of his profession or business or not and although not of a nature requiring employment of a Solicitor or other professional person

IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand to this my will this *Eighteenth* day of *February* one thousand nine hundred and sixty nine
