

Latter Rain of the Holy Spirit begins on Pentecost Day, July 18, 2021

Ja. 5:7 KJV Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

The husbandman is Jesus Christ. He has been waiting to gather the precious fruit of the earth, which he labored for. The fruit are the human sons of God. Ingathering of the fruit of the earth, the rapture, can only happen after the latter rain of the Holy Spirit. The early rain came down about 2,000 years ago, just after Jesus Christ ascended to heaven after his resurrection from the dead. I hereby announce that the latter rain of the Holy Spirit, great fountain of living water, will begin next Sunday. Next Sunday is the Pentecost day, according to the ancient Hebrew calendar. The modern Jewish calendar is out of phase with the ancient Hebrew calendar by +2 months.

Ex. 17:1 The whole Israelite community set out from the Desert of Sin, travelling from place to place as the LORD commanded. They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink.

Ex. 17:2 So they quarrelled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink." Moses replied, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you put the LORD to the test?"

Ex. 17:4 Then Moses cried out to the LORD, "What am I to do with these people? They are almost ready to stone me."

Ex. 17:5 The LORD answered Moses, "Walk on ahead of the people. Take with you some of the elders of Israel and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go.

Ex. 17:6 I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink." So Moses did this in the sight of the elders of Israel.

Shavuot (Feast of Pentecost) is actually the commemoration of the first water from the rock. The Israelites drank water from the rock before they reached the desert of Sinai, where they received the law.

Nu. 20:2 Now there was no water for the community, and the people gathered in opposition to Moses and Aaron.

Nu. 20:6 Moses and Aaron went from the assembly to the entrance to the Tent of Meeting and fell face down, and the glory of the LORD appeared to them.

Nu. 20:7 The LORD said to Moses,

Nu. 20:8 "Take the staff, and you and your brother Aaron gather the assembly together. Speak to that rock before their eyes and it will pour out its water. You will bring water out of the rock for the community so that they and their livestock can drink."

In the fortieth year of the movement of Israelites from Egypt to the Promised Land, the second water from the rock happened. Once the Israelites drank this second water from the rock, the final thrust to the Promised Land began, after years of wandering aimlessly in the desert. Obviously, the second water from the rock enabled the Israelites to make

the final thrust to the Promised Land. They got to the Promised Land less than one year after drinking the second water from the rock. The second water from the rock took place on Shavuot (Feast of Pentecost), but by then the Israelites had not started celebrating the appointed feasts, being still in the desert.

The latter rain of the Holy Spirit is the antitype of the second water from the rock. The rapture will take place less than one year from the beginning of the latter rain of the Holy Spirit.

The latter rain of the Holy Spirit will trigger the manifestation of the sons of God (Ro. 8:19), which is also the great end-time revival. Incidentally, Is. 60:2 says that the manifestation of the sons of God will happen at a time when thick darkness covers the world.

Mt. 24:7 Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be famines and earthquakes in various places.

Mt. 24:8 All these are the beginning of birth-pains.

Mt. 24:9 "Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me.

Mt. 24:10 At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other,

Mt. 24:11 and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people.

Mt. 24:12 Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold,

Mt. 24:13 but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

Mt. 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

The world is about to change suddenly.

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
